REDUCE NOISE

Drown out the bangs with TV or radio

ENVIRONMENT

Set your pet up in a room with their favourite things

WALK

Take your dog for an extra long walk in daylight

ORGANISATION

Prepare well in advance

REASSURANCE

Stay with your pets and keep them settled

KITTENS/PUPPIES

Young ones can be extra sensitive to loud noises

SECURITY

Make sure all doors, cat-flaps and windows are secured
